Friday, November 25

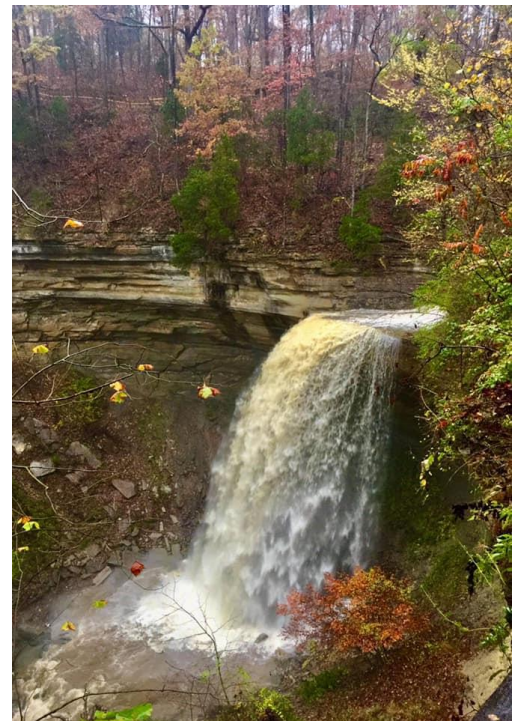
