Clifty Falls State Park
February 2022

Saturday, February 5

10am Woodpecker Walk - Did you know there are seven species of woodpeckers that call Clifty Falls home? Grab your binoculars and meet the naturalist at **Clifty Shelter** to go on a 45-minute ADA accessible walk to search for them. Note: The restroom at Clifty Shelter will be closed for the winter, so please plan ahead.

3pm Campground Clean-up - Meet at the **Campground Gatehouse** to help pick up trash throughout the campground. The clean-up will last 1-hour, and trash bags and gloves will be provided. Admission is free!

Thursday, February 10

6-7pm Friends Group Meeting - Join our parks Friends Group! Meet us at the **Clifty Inn** to find out how you can become more involved in volunteering to better our park for current and future generations. Meet new people, while having the opportunity to learn and grow!

Saturday, February 12

10am Waterfall Hike - Meet at **Clifty Shelter** for a 1 hour moderately rugged hike through one of the most scenic sections of Clifty Canyon. There's a chance to see 5 waterfalls along the way! Note: The restroom at Clifty Shelter will be closed for the winter, so please plan ahead.

1pm Live Birds of Prey! - Join us in the **Hoffman Room** at the **Inn** to meet some live birds of prey from Hardy Lake. A **\$2/person** fee will be charged for this 1-hour program to benefit the Dwight Chamberlain Raptor Rehabilitation Center.

10am Winters Whistlers - Meet at the **Nature Center** for a 1-hour easy hike to look and listen for our feathered friends. Bring your binoculars!
