Saturday, April 3

2pm Women's Hiking Group Meet-Up - Ladies! Join us for our monthly group hike where you can get outdoors and meet like-minded women. This 1 hour hike is rugged. Meet at **Poplar Grove Shelter**.

3pm Waterfall Hike - Meet at **Clifty Shelter** for a 1 hour moderately rugged hike through one of the most scenic sections of Clifty Canyon. There's a chance to see 5 waterfalls along the way!

10am Backyard Birdwatching - Come to the **Nature Center** and help us put out some birdseed in our wildlife observation area, and then see what comes to the feeders. 2pm Create a Wildflower - Design your very own tissue paper flower at the **Nature Center**. 30 minutes.

2:30pm Stained Glass Vases - Create a colorful vase that can be used for flowers you pick from your yard, or you can even put your tissue paper flowers in it from our previous program! This 30 minute craft will take place at the **Nature Center** and costs \$5.

Wildflower Weekend!

10am Wildflower Hike - Meet at the **Poplar Grove Shelter** for a 1 ½ hour **rugged** hike to search for spring wildflowers of all colors.

2pm Wildflower Stroll - Meet at the **Pool** to venture out on a search for spring flowers on this 1 hour moderate hike.

Saturday, April 24

10-11am Volunteer Callout - Meet at the **Nature Center** at 10am to discover how easy it is to become a state park volunteer! Find out what volunteer opportunities are available such as critter care, invasive species removal, or helping with our pollinator garden. We will have volunteer applications and snacks/water available.

10:30am-Noon Garlic Mustard Pull - Jump right in and volunteer with us by removing the pesky invasive plant, garlic mustard, from our park. Discover how to identify this invasive species and find out how it's hurting our ecosystem, and then we'll pull as many plants as we can until noon. Please bring your own work gloves! Meet at the **Nature Center**.

2pm Bluebird Walk - Join the naturalist at **Clifty Shelter** to check our bluebird boxes for nests, eggs, and babies. 45 minute easy walk.

Sunday, April 25

10am Scat and Tracks 101 - Join the naturalist at the **Nature Center** to discover how to identify various animal tracks and poo, and make an animal tracks ID sheet. Then we'll venture out for a short easy hike to look for what our wildlife has left behind on the trail. 1 hour program.

3pm Stream Safari - Gather at the outdoor **pool** to take a short easy hike down the trail to explore one of the many streams in our park. We'll search for insects, salamanders and more! Be sure to wear your water shoes, and be prepared to get wet! 1 hour program.
