Sunday, May 1

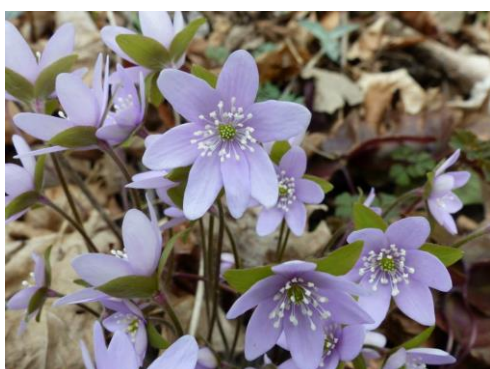
