Saturday, March 2

10am Story and Sensory Walk - It's National Read Across America Day and March 1 was National Day of Unplugging, so we thought why not celebrate both at one time. Come to the **Nature Center** for story time with the naturalist, then go on a short, easy sensory walk to the observation tower during this 45-minute program.

1pm Live Birds of Prey - Join us at **Clifty Shelter** to meet some live birds of prey from Hardy Lake. Please bring a cash donation for this 1-hour program to benefit the Dwight Chamberlain Raptor Rehabilitation Center.

3pm Bluebird Box Workshop - Encourage bluebirds to take up residence in your backyard by building a house for them. This workshop, sponsored by the Friends of Clifty Falls State Park, is limited to 10 people and there is a \$20 fee. We will meet at Clifty Shelter. **Please call 812-273-0609 to register.**

8pm Timberdoodles Sky Dance - Meet at the outdoor **Pool** for this 30-minute program to watch for the courtship display of the American Woodcock. Their display, known as the *sky dance*, is best viewed at dawn and dusk.

Sunday, March 24

10am Slime vs. Scales - Explore the unique adaptations of some of our live reptiles and amphibians during this 45-minute program at the **Nature Center**. There will be an opportunity to touch a live snake or turtle!

Saturday, March 30

10am Whose Nest is This? - Discover how to identify bird nests and eggs. Then paint an egg to take home with you during this hour-long program at the Nature Center.
2pm Spring Scavenger Hunt - Join the naturalist at the Nature Center for this hour-long moderate hike to search for items on the scavenger hunt list, or if you would like to complete the scavenger hunt solo, you can pick up a list any time before 3pm at the nature center. Once you have photos of all the items on the list, show your photos to the naturalist to receive a small prize, and be entered into a drawing for an annual pass.
