MAP - THE SERPENT OF 62

REWYED ROUTE

- North on **US 421** out of Madison
- Right (East) on Hwy **62** to Friendship and Dillsboro
- Right (East) on Hwy 262 to Rising Sun
- Right (West) on Hwy **56** towards Vevay
- Traight (West) on Hwy 156 to Vevay
- Straight (West) on Hwy **56** back to Madison

RIDE TO STREAM CLIFF

RETRACING MORGAN'S RAID

44.5 MILES A 45-mile ride of tree-shaded curves and limestone valleys leading to Stream Cliff Farm's winery and gardens, with traces of Morgan's Raid history and peaceful Muscatatuck River scenery along the way.

MAP - RIDE TO STREAM CLIFF

REVYED ROUTE

- West on Main Street into the heart of downtown
- Right on Rte. 7
- Left to stay on 7
- **6** Left on Deputy Pike
- Right Rte. 3
- Right on 115W to Stream Cliff
- Reverse path back out on 115W
- Left on Rte. 3
- ① Left on **250**
- Right on 7
- Right to stay on 7
- **Solution** Left on Main Street and back through downtown Madison

POINTS OF INTEREST Stream Cliff Historic Farm Winery, Restaurant; Historic Eleutherian College; Hoyt House; Morgan's Raid (in Dupont, IN); Neavill's Grove; Old Class Service Station; Historic Madison, IN

MARKLAND: MADE IN AMERICA

REVYED ROUTE

- East on Main Street (US 421) towards Vevay
- Left (East) on Hwy **56** at the Madison-Milton bridge (don't cross bridge)
- ① Straight (East) on Hwy **156** in Vevay
- Left on Hwy 101 at Markland dam to cross the river on the bridge
- Right onto Hwy 42 after crossing Markland dam bridge
- **Solution** Left onto Hwy **42** (East) towards Carrollton & Madison
- ① Straight through Carrollton on 42/36
- **1** Stay Straight on **36** to Milton
- In Milton, pick up **421** North to Madison (cross the bridge)

POINTS OF INTEREST The Markland Dam & Bridge; Historic Vevay, IN; Belterra Casino; Trimble County, KY; Downtown Carrollton, KY; Richwood on the River; Historic Madison, Indiana

JACOB'S LADDER

A LITTLE TASTE OF TWISTY KENTUCKY

3B.4 MILES A nearly 40-mile backroad adventure with sweeping vistas, plunging creeks, country churches, and narrow, twisty stretches that demand sharp attention—founder, Curt Jacobs Sr.'s favorite ride.

MAP - JACOB'S LADDER

REVYED ROUTE

- ① South on 421 across bridge and up the hill
- **S** Left on **1492**
- Right on East Prong Locust Creek
- Right on 1226
- Right on Culls Ridge
- ① Culls Ridge turns into West Prong Locust Creek
- T" onto 1492 at Red Barn and turn right
- Follow **1492** all the way down to Ohio River and then left on **36**
- Left on Hunter Heights Road (about ½ mile past Nugent Sand & Gravel)
- Right on 1492 and back out to 421
- Right on 421, then down the hill and across bridge back to Madison

THE ARK LOOP

CURVIEST RIDE IN ALL CREATION!

124.5 MILES A full-day, 4-hour round-trip through rolling Kentucky Bluegrass and scenic river roads, with views of American industry along the Ohio and a dramatic turnaround at the towering Ark Encounter.

MAP - ARK LOOP

REYYED ROUTE

- East on Main Street (US 421) towards Kentucky
- Stay on 421 South as it curves and crosses the bridge
- Ocurving off the bridge, take a left on 36 (in front of the Dairy Queen)
- Stay on **36** through Carrollton, and then turn right to stay on **36**
- About a mile up from Carrollton, turn left to stay on 36
- Stay on **36** (turn right) through Sanders
- About 3 miles out of Sanders, turn right on **36** as it joins **227**
- Veer left to stay on **36E**
- Right to stay on 36 as it joins 127
- You'll come to the Ark Encounter about 59 miles out
- Turn ground and come back on the same route
- Turn right as 36N joins 127
- **1** Go straight on Route **35**, heading towards Sparta
- Pass the Kentucky Speedway on your left
- In the river town of Warsaw, turn left on 42
- Stay straight on **42** all the way to Carrollton
- **1** Straight through Carrollton on **42/36** to Madison
- ① Stay Straight on 36 to Milton
- In Milton, pick up **421** North to Madison (cross the bridge)
